Dear Temporary Volunteer Applicant:

We appreciate the willingness you show by volunteering to serve Jehovah and your brothers as a temporary volunteer in the United States Bethel.—Psalm 110:3.

Most of those invited as temporary volunteers are those with a particular skill or experience needed at Bethel. Applicants should be between the ages of 19 and 55, and baptized at least one year. Spiritual qualifications are of the greatest importance. One must be wholly dedicated to Jehovah and demonstrate Christian maturity, having a zeal for Kingdom service.

Applicants generally apply to serve for one or two weeks or up to and including three months. All those applying should have the full support of their family. Their absence should not create an undue hardship on the family. If you are married and apply for more than four weeks, both you and your mate should apply. All temporary volunteers should be willing to serve wherever they are assigned.

After completing the application, please give it to your Congregation Service Committee to process and forward to the branch office. If your circumstances change or if you are available on dates other than those noted on your application, please send a letter informing the branch office. If you are invited, you will be advised well enough in advance for you to make necessary arrangements. After considering the application, you may decide not to apply at this time. In that event, please return it to the congregation secretary.

May Jehovah's blessing continue with you as you continue sharing zealously in the disciple-making work in your part of the field.—Matthew 28:19, 20.
