Average meeting attendance: Obtain the average meeting attendance figures by adding the "Average Attendance Each Week" figures on the *Congregation Meeting Attendance Record* for each month, September 2019 through August 2020, and dividing by 12. Please round off figures to the nearest whole number.

Active publishers: Obtain by counting the number of publishers (including pioneers) who reported service during one or more of the last six months, March through August 2020. *All* publishers, baptized and unbaptized, regular and irregular, are included in this number.

Inactive publishers: Obtain by counting the number of publishers who have not reported field service for six consecutive months. That six-month period could end in any of the 12 months between September 2019 and August 2020. Those who became inactive in previous years and have remained inactive should not be counted.

Reactivated publishers: Obtain by counting the number of publishers who had been inactive but who started reporting field service again in any of the 12 months between September 2019 and August 2020. (It is possible for the same person to be included in the total number of inactive publishers and the total number of reactivated publishers.)

Deaf publishers: How many deaf publishers who depend on sign language are in the congregation?

Blind publishers: How many blind and visually impaired publishers are in the congregation?

Total number of territories:

How many of these territories have not been worked during the past service year? Territories covered in special campaigns are considered worked and should not be included here.

Would the congregation accept assistance if the branch office could send groups to help cover such territory?
