Dear Brothers:

Throughout the centuries faithful servants of Jehovah have shown a pattern of generosity by using their resources for true worship.

When the tabernacle was being constructed, the Israelites were invited to “take up a contribution for Jehovah.” (Ex. 35:5-9) Not only were silver and gold contributed but also less valuable things; copper, blue thread, dyed material, ram skins, seal skins and acacia wood, all very useful for the construction of the tabernacle.

In a similar way, we are engaged in a building project connected with Jehovah’s worship—our new branch at Chelmsford. Although most branch building projects have been cancelled or curtailed at this time, the Governing Body has advised that our project must now proceed without delay. Already, you dear brothers have done so well, sending gifts both large and small. For instance, two children, five and seven years old, sent their pocket money to help build our new Bethel instead of going to the circus, writing, “This is much better than that!”

As shown with the construction of the tabernacle, donations can be made in various ways. Some have sent us items of value. Others send us cheques payable to “International Bible Students Association.” Here are two other methods to consider:

Telephone: You can call our donation line on 020 8371 3359 between 8:00 a.m. and 12 noon or 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, using your debit or credit card to donate.

When donating by any method, please let us know if you are a taxpayer, because your donation can then be enhanced by 25 per cent at no extra cost to you.

This letter will be put on the Kingdom Hall noticeboard, so you can refer to it as needed.

We join you in praying for Jehovah’s blessing on all the exciting developments in the worldwide work, in particular our own branch relocation project.
