This page will also allow you to make donations to the worldwide work using any major credit card or any debit card labeled Visa or MasterCard. To use this arrangement, the donor will need a card that has a billing address matching the country he selects on jw.org. One-time donations may be made without creating an account. You may also set up a login account to make donations regularly. Setting up a login account reduces the accounting work at the branch office, allows you to create a recurring donation, and allows you to see your donation history. All donations will be immediately confirmed by e-mail. A few days after the donation is received, a donation acknowledgment letter will be e-mailed to the donor. If you have any questions on how to use this arrangement, please feel free to contact one of your local elders or another capable brother to assist you.
