Re: Use of *Bible Teach* and *Teach Us*

Dear Brothers:

We are writing to provide further information regarding the new publication entitled *What Can the Bible Teach Us?* As previously announced, this book covers the same subjects as *What Does the Bible Really Teach?* However, it does not replace the *Bible Teach* book. Rather, *Teach Us* will be useful when studying with individuals who may need to have the truth presented in a simpler manner. In addition to having simplified text and illustrations, the *Teach Us* book has two-page summaries at the end of each chapter. Instead of an appendix, it uses endnotes that closely relate to the “Glossary of Bible Terms” in the revised *New World Translation*.

In most cases, publishers will find that the *Bible Teach* book serves very well when they are teaching on Bible studies. Suppose, though, that the student does not read well or is limited in his reading comprehension? A simpler presentation may be needed in order to reach his heart. In such a case, the *Teach Us* book may be used to good effect. Since the goal of conducting Bible studies is to help individuals to dedicate their life to Jehovah based on accurate knowledge, each publisher will need to discern whether the *Bible Teach* or *Teach Us* book would prove most effective.

We trust that having this additional publication available will provide greater opportunity to present the good news to individuals in a manner that appeals to the heart.
