This document will guide you through how to check for your internet speed and how to printscreen your result.

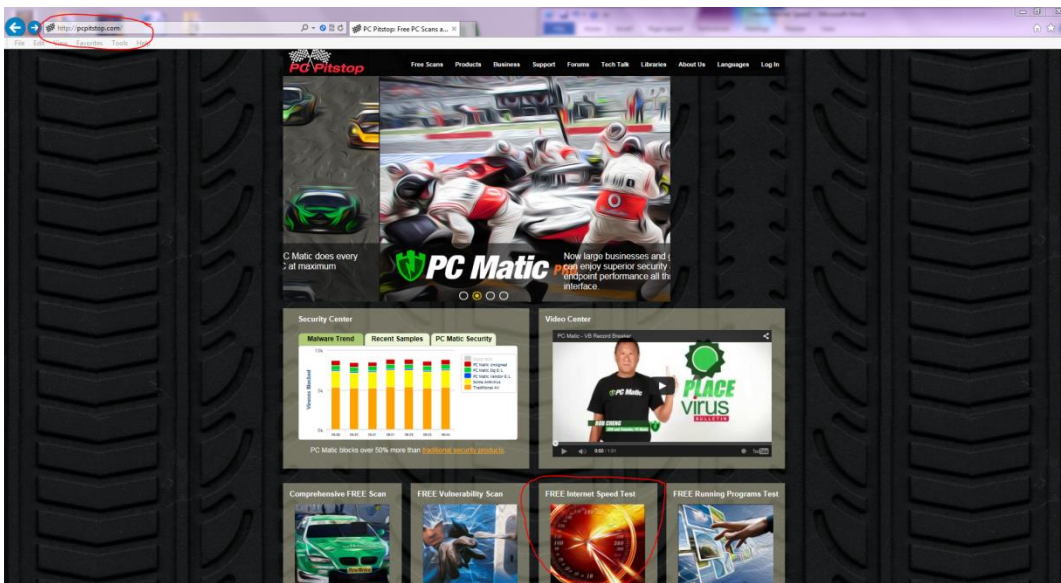
We assume you have connected your laptop to the internet.

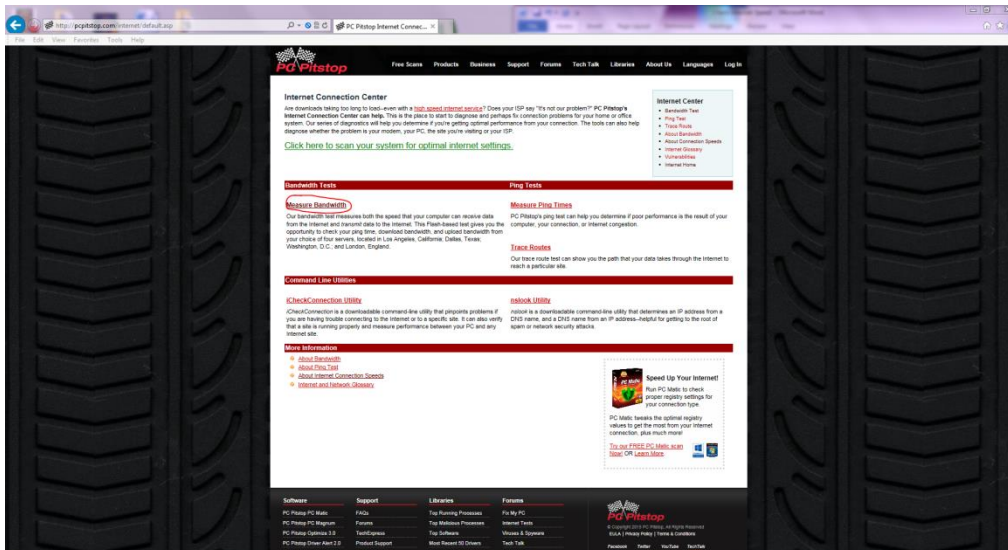
Section 1

Checking your internet Speed.

1. Open your internet Browser (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox) and type www.pcpistop.com in the address bar.
2. Click on **free Internet Speed Test**



3. Click on **measure bandwidth**.
