

SHOWING RESPECT FOR THE HOUSE OF GOD

Dear visitor,

We are delighted to welcome you to visit our Bethel. The word 'Bethel' means 'House of God'. Therefore, we should dress and conduct ourselves as we would when we attend meetings at the Kingdom Hall (od p. 126 par. 13) How can we 'behave in a manner worthy of the good news' when visiting Accra Bethel? (Philippians 1:27) We are happy to provide the following directions.

TOILETS

*We kindly request that you leave the toilets CLEAN after use as this brings honor to Jehovah
Philippians 2:4 'look out not only for your own interests, but also for the interests of others'*

- Upon arrival at Bethel, the public toilets are located in the top corner of the car park and are clearly marked MEN & WOMEN. **Please use the correct one.**
- PARENTS: Please ACCOMPANY YOUR CHILDREN & check to see the place is left clean for the next user. Do not allow your children to waste expensive water.
- **ONLY** TOILET PAPER should be put down the toilet
No PAMPERS, SANITARY PADS or HAND DRYING PAPERS should be put in the toilet bowl.

- Please flush the toilet after use. If there is still residue in the toilet bowl, wipe with toilet brush and flush again.
- Pick all papers off the floor and put them in the bin.
- Do not leave the water tap running. This wastes money.
- If the toilet roll is finished, please replace it with a new one for the next user.
- Please encourage the children to wash their hands after using the toilet. Use the soap dispenser.

SUMMER HUT

- The water beside the summer hut is safe to drink. Please do not waste water. Please bring your own water bottle which can be filled as needed when on tour.
- Children are not to be allowed to wander onto the roads inside or outside of Bethel.

DURING THE TOUR

- Please stay with your group. Children should not be allowed to wander off. This is dangerous.
- As the Bethel family is still working, please try to keep the noise levels down.
- Try not to block the corridors or entrance doors.
- Do not allow the children to disturb the birds or animals or try to touch them or throw stones at them.
- Please put all garbage in the garbage bins.
- At the end of the tour, please return to the summer hut.
