TO THE BODY OF ELDERS AND PPAM ELDER COORDINATORS

Subject: Recommended procedure when aggression occurs in public witnessing

Dear Brothers:

The Legal Department of the Branch has prepared practical guidelines to follow in the event that aggressive conduct affects public preaching activity.

Attached is a document entitled “What to do in case of aggression in public witnessing”, which contains instructions. Please analyze the contents of this document and give the necessary instructions to the publishers who participate in the PPOC organized through the service overseer. In the case of PPAM, the overseer of each shift should review them frequently. It is important that a copy of the document be left in the carts used in the public witnessing area.

We also attach a second document entitled “Model Complaint for Aggression in Public Witnessing” in *Word* format; if it becomes necessary to make a complaint this can be used as a template, writing in the information. It is not necessary to have this document in the carts, as the complaint can be presented to the Court later. If the police were to make the complaint, they would use an official form, although it would be useful to request that the aspects indicated in our “Model Complaint” be included.
