

## No. 27 Getting Marriage Off to a Good Start

### **MARRIAGE IS A SACRED COMMITMENT** (4 min.)

Marriage is a gift from Jehovah God that can bring great joy to both husband and wife [Read **Genesis 2:23, 24**] (Ge 2:18-22)

God created marriage to be an honorable arrangement and a permanent union (Mr 10:9; Heb 13:4; /vs 148 ¶5)

In the Bible, Jehovah provides wise counsel that can help new couples build a strong marriage

### **BE READY TO MAKE ADJUSTMENTS AFTER MARRIAGE** (12 min.)

After your wedding day, you may be surprised by some of your mate's imperfections

Be patient and quick to forgive [Read **1 Corinthians 13:4, 5**] [Image 1]

Instead of focusing on your mate's faults, focus on his or her good qualities

Learn to put your mate's interests ahead of your own (1Co 10:24)

Be flexible and willing to yield

Kindly consider your mate's sexual needs, and avoid acting selfishly (1Co 7:3-5; w16.08 15 ¶7-9)

Do not look to the past; the two of you are now a team (Ec 4:9, 10; 7:10)

Do not compare your mate with others or show romantic interest in anyone else (Pr 5:15-18)

Your bond with your mate now takes priority over relationships with parents, family, and friends (w11 10/15 16-17 ¶18; w11 1/15 14 ¶9)

### **LEARN TO COMMUNICATE WELL** (10 min.)

Communicate openly, even when difficulties arise [Read **Ephesians 4:26, 27**] [Image 2]

Talk matters out, listening respectfully to each other (Pr 25:11; Jas 1:19; w13 5/15 15-16 ¶4-8)

Tactfully express your needs and desires; do not expect your mate to read your mind

Handle disagreements with love (Col 3:14)

Have realistic expectations; no two people will agree on everything

Apply the Bible's practical advice on making peace (Pr 12:18; 26:20)

### **BUILD A STRONG MARRIAGE BY APPLYING BIBLE PRINCIPLES** (4 min.)

A marriage guided by Bible principles brings both partners security, and it honors Jehovah

Make sure to keep Jehovah in your marriage [Read **Ecclesiastes 4:12**] [Image 3]

Regularly studying the Bible together will draw you closer together (w08 3/15 10 ¶11)

Pray together daily

With Jehovah's help, you can build a lasting, happy marriage
